With UNICEF support the government activated WASH sub-cluster during emergencies leading to efficient coordination among sector agencies. WASH sub-cluster is coordinated by Ministry of Social Affairs and UNICEF and includes all agencies who are involved in Water and Sanitation. This coordination helped agencies to identify gaps in response, and to reach most marginalized communities, including special needs of women and girls during emergencies. UNICEF is increasingly promoting climate resilient WASH services as a means to better prepare and minimize damage to existing infrastructure during disasters
