In coordination with UNICEF HQ, the Hand Hygiene Accelerated Framework was developed by UNICEF and Ministry of Environment as part of HH4A initiative to accelerate progress towards universal hand hygiene by 2030 and initiated policy strengthening and developed an action plan. UNICEF interventions resulted in 119,958 children and young people in schools, healthcare facilities, and communities, returnee areas, informal settlements and in second displacement gaining access to sustainable water and sanitation. Girls in schools benefited from trainings with doctors and dissemination of menstrual health tool kits while social mobilization and community engagement raised awareness on water conservation and hygiene promotion
