The CLAC informed actions needed to secure the rights of children in relation to climate change in Iraq. UNICEF safeguarded against climate threats through transition to climate resilient, disability and gender appropriate programming in WASH and continued engagement with youth as agents of change. Strengthened water resource management and addressing water scarcity in KRI through revitalization of dried out springs through rainwater harvesting ponds and techniques, enhanced water resources in rural communities. Children and youth engaged in mainstreaming technology transfer through efforts that increased knowledge of students in school and universities ensuring their voices were heard in climate policymaking processes.
