Based on the Humanitarian Response Plan, over 2.4 million people were reached in 2022 with life-saving WASH services through UNICEF interventions such as construction and rehabilitation of systems, provision of WASH emergency supplies including water treatment chemicals, hygiene awareness, and kits that included menstrual health and hygiene items for women and girls. Building on the sector leadership that was strengthened over the 2018-2022 country programme, the Government was also supported in 2022 to improve WASH in emergency coordination, preparedness and response, and two states were supported to finalize the development, approval and launch of their cholera preparedness and response plan.
