Major achievements this year contributed to the overall achievement of the CPD targets including assessment of the social service workforce for child protection; establishment of the Social Service Coordination Group; development of curriculum for auxiliary social workers; and harmonization of all case management tools in the six geopolitical zones. Access to child justice was substantively improved with 2,362 children reached with legal aid and community reintegration services compared with 218 in 2021. The unprecedented launch of the Movement for Good to End FGM has empowered adolescent girls, youth and women groups to advocate for the eradication of the practice.
