Full Output Statement: The health systems at national level and in select provinces are strengthened to accelerate equitable access to high impactinterventions for reducing preventable newborn deaths, early childhood illnesses and disability, which contributes to Cross Sectoral - Children With Disabilities, Cross-Sectoral - Planning And Programme Reviews, Cross-Sectoral - Social And Behaviour Change, Evaluation, Health And Development In Early Childhood And Adolescence, Immunization Services As Part Of Primary Health Care, Reducing Child Poverty, Research, Safe And Equitable Water, Sanitation And Hygiene Services And Practices, Strengthening Primary Health Care And High-Impact Health Interventions, Strengthening Primary Health Care And High-Impact Health Interventions (Covid), Supply And Logistics, Water, Sanitation And Hygiene Systems And Empowerment Of Communities. UNICEF supported DOH in developing the health sector strategy 2023-2028, vaccine plan, supported the vaccination of 8,164,000 under-five children with MR vaccine and 2,344,979 with OPV (MR-OPV SIA), and 555,666 with PENTA 1 (catch up immunization). SBC support reached 8.8 million people with COVID-19, immunization, and SIA messages. Likewise, UNICEF supported DOH and DepEd in drafting the implementation guidelines for Healthy Learning Institutions. Child Road Traffic Injury programme and modeling in four cities, with signed MOUs with NGAs and local ordinances. Emergency preparedness remained a key programming pillar with focus on capacity building of 70 health staff at sub-national level.
