UNICEF scaled up emergency health response supporting the provision of life-saving interventions to the most vulnerable groups in the context of the ongoing protracted emergency that is coupled with disrupted health systems and service delivery. With UNICEF support, a total of 8,550,306 children U5 were reached with polio vaccination, 960,797 children received measles vaccine, 571,155 received IMCI services. UNICEF released Cholera kits to treat 4000 moderate to severe cholera cases in CTC operated by health partners. UNICEF is supporting establishing 120 ORTs corners in affected states.
